





Take Hwy. 90 West from S.A.  
In Uvalde, turn Left on Hwy. 83  
at Courthouse Square.  
Head South on Hwy. 83 1/2 mile. Road  
forks at F.M. 117 & Hwy. 83.  
Continue straight on F.M. 117 for 1 mile.  
Turn Left on F.M. 140 toward Pearsall. Go 3 miles.  
Turn Left on County Road #365. Go 6 miles  
Road dead-ends. Turn Left. Look for the flag at "ranch headquarters" office.
